In the filled grid, six symmetricallyplaced Across answers (with normal clues) will form an ambiguous nine-word wordplay-only clue to the seven-letter key words for *both* plans. In case the clue is a bit obscure, all the rest of the Across clues have wordplay yielding a letter sequence with an extra letter at the start and end of the answer; the start letters, and separately the end letters, will give those two key words.

Each Down clue has an extra letter that must be deleted before solving; in clue order, these letters will spell out where we will travel if we follow one plan, or what will do if we follow the other.
