It's a Strange Sing by Ucaoimhu

This competition has some peculiarities, each of which affects four Down answers before entry:

No US. You must remove U and S.

Complicated point counting. A Roman numeral in the answer must be doubled, increased by 40, and put in front.

The ultimate in retro-futurism. The last letter must be moved two places back in the alphabet, and a copy of it, moved two places *forward* in the alphabet instead, must be inserted two places back in the *answer*.

(Three altered entries will have hyphens, capitals, and/or multiple words; in addition, each altered entry is clued by some sequence of words in the clue.)

Once the grid is filled, one main diagonal in the grid will contain an important term; apply all three rules in order to this term to get a second important term. In addition, all other clues have an extra letter, which must be removed before solving. In clue order, the extra letters from Across clues will name a third important term encompassing the second; if a form of this third term has the extra letters from the Down clues added, it will form a fourth term, for some key people involved in this competition.
