Mass. Conceptions by Ucaoimhu

Even at a Friendsgiving in the state where it all began, we may need to dispell some Thanksgiving misconceptions:

- (1) The domestic Thanksgiving turkey, which is basically a giant flightless bird, is quite unlike the wild turkey seen at the legendary "First Thanksgiving" (or in random Mass. locations today). Ten clues are ambiguous "Schrödinger clues," yielding two possible answers, which differ only in the letter in one unchecked square. One possible letter is always the same; enter the other, and circle it. Left to right, the circled letters will say what we know was served at the First Thanksgiving; top to bottom, they will name an attendee known for his advisory and interpretive abilities.
- (2) The First Thanksgiving also played more strongly into the local power struggles than some appreciate. Ten more clues each have wordplay yielding a letter string with one wrong letter. In clue order, the wrong letters will depict an English laborer of the time, but the right letters will depict the great Massassoit himself; the latter plus the former will also justify the use of the single alternate letter in (1).
- (3) Finally, (1) and (2) themselves have gotten something wrong. Each of the remaining ten clues has one wrong letter, which must be corrected before solving; the set of wrong letters is just the set of right letters rearranged. The wrong letters, and then the right letters (each in clue order) will say what kind of mistake (1) and (2) have made.
